

# Yucai Afterschool Program

## Introduction

Yucai Afterschool Program is intended to provide students an opportunity to use Chinese every day (4 days/week). Students can also participate in enrichment classes (e.g. chess, debate, theater, and dance). Yucai Afterschool provides Friday care as well. As a result, students can immerse themselves in Chinese every day as well as develop their interests in various extracurricular activities.

## Curriculum

Yucai Afterschool Program offers five levels (Level 1 to Level 5) of Chinese instruction. We will use the textbook titled "**Meizhou Chinese**". The textbook comes as a set, consisting of the textbook itself, students' workbook, vocabulary flash cards and audio CD.



## Date and Time

Yucai Afterschool follows Wayzata School District calendar.

**Chinese class:** 2:30-4:10pm, M-Th  
**Enrichment class:** 4:20-5:20pm, M-Th  
**Friday care:** 2:30-5:20pm, Fridays only

# Yucai After-School Registration Frequently Asked Questions

## 1. What does it take to register?

**Step 1:** Fill out an online registration on Yucai school's website(<http://www.yucaimn.org>) or **scan QR code on the right:**



**Step 2:** Print out the summary page. The summary page appears once you click on "submit" on the registration page.

**Step 3:** Mail the registration summary page, the \$300.00 non-refundable deposit per student (check only), and other necessary paperwork (e.g. IEP, payment plan request) to the following address.

## 2. Is there a registration fee?

## 3. Is there a sibling discount for the tuition?

## 4. Early bird discount

**5% off the total if the tuition is paid in full before July 31<sup>st</sup> (postmarked)**

## 5. What payment plan does Yucai offer?

Families who have financial hardships and cannot pay the tuition in a lump sum are eligible to use the payment plan. The payment plan may vary. We foresee two installments, fall and spring.

## 6. When is the tuition due?

The full tuition is due September 1st.

## 7. Is there a late pick-up policy?

Yes. The Chinese section ends at 4:10pm. Late fees, \$1.00 per minute, start to accrue after 4:20pm. The enrichment section ends at 5:20pm. Late fees, \$1.00 per minute, start to accrue after 5:30pm.

Yucai collects a \$100.00 refundable deposit per student at the time of tuition payment in addition to the tuition. This amount of money is intended for late pick-ups and other unforeseeable expenses. This deposit will be refunded or credited at the end of the school year minus deductions if assessed.

## 8. Is there a refund if a family decides to withdraw after fully registered?

Yes. For the fall semester, tuition (excluding \$300 deposit) is fully refunded when a written cancellation request is received by September 1st. Tuition is non-refundable after September 1st. For spring semester, 50% tuition can be refunded when a written cancellation request is received by December 1<sup>st</sup> with a \$100.00 cancellation fee. Tuition is non-refundable after December 1st.

9. Yucai Chinese School is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization and not a daycare center. We offer after-school Chinese classes, as well as an after-class program in the afternoon to support parents needing a later pick up time. Occasionally, we receive questions about the use of FSA dollars to pay for Yucai Chinese class expenses. We recommend checking with your accountant and/or benefits administrator for guidance on this topic.
